Rules and Regulations

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WILL BE CONDUCTED UNDER THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK. It is expected that exhibitors, owners, lessees, trainers and coaches will be familiar with the Federation breed and class specifications regarding your particular breed / discipline. A current Federation Rule Book will be available in the Horse Show Office.

Entries

All entries must be signed by the (1) exhibitor, (2) the rider, driver, handler, vaulter or longeur, (3) the trainer, and (4) the coach, if applicable, or by the agent(s) of such person(s) and must be accompanied by funds to cover entry fees, stall fees and Federation fee (see GR208.1). In the case of a rider, driver, handler, vaulter or longeur under the age of 18, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer, must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf. **Entries can be made through Horse Shows Online or by mailing a hard-copy entry form to the Show Secretary.** Online entries will need to provide payments through Venmo or provide a check before the entry is considered complete. *Online entries: Go to horseshowsonline.com>ShowSelector.aspx and search for Winterfest (in the Upcoming Shows tab) to find the online entry form.*

Post Entries

Post entries are any entries made after the advertised closing date of January 31, 2023. Per Federation rule GR910.2, the Federation does not encourage post entries, and strongly urges Horse Show Committees to require that entries be made in advance. Any entry received after the closing date of January 31, 2023 will be considered a post entry and will be accepted, at the discretion of the Horse Show Management, with an additional charge of \$35 per horse, payment in full (or a signed, blank check made payable to Colorado Fall Charity Horse Show) and a fully completed and signed Entry Blank. **Post entries can only be accepted prior to the starting of the class and upon signature of exhibitor or his/her agent and trainer.**

Personal Checks

Any check refused by the bank for any reason will be assessed a \$30.00 penalty. Then the full obligation, plus the \$30.00 penalty, must be covered by a money order, cashier's check or cash. Additionally, any and all entries for which a refused check is written will forfeit all paybacks. All checks must be pre-printed with the current information (name, address and telephone number). **Per Federation Rule GR913, if a person fails to make settlement with the competition and/or the Federation within 30 days from the date of the notice from the Federation, he or she will be fined the additional sum of \$250 payable to the Federation and he or she and any horses owned by him or her and any horses and/or persons for which the non-negotiable sums have been paid will automatically be barred from taking any part whatsoever in any competition Licensed or endorsed by the Federation until settlement is made both of indebtedness to the Competition and to the Federation.**

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to refuse payment in the form of a check from any exhibitor.

Office and Exercise Schedules

Schedules for office hours and exercising times will be posted at the Show Secretary's office.

Courtesy and Disputes

The Winterfest Horse Show reserves the right to eliminate from competition and remove from show grounds, without liability or recourse of any kind, any exhibitor(s) or person(s) who exhibit offensive behavior, engage in any illegal activity, display disrespect to officials, exhibitors, volunteers, spectators, or any other participants. Such conduct will disqualify horse(s) from adjudication and the owner shall forfeit entrance and all fees. Exhibitors shall not approach the judge regarding a decision without first requesting permission from Show Management. No disputes shall be heard by the Show Committee until the horse show is over. Decisions made by the Show Management shall be considered final.

Condition of Entry

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Winterfest Horse Show Management. Neither the Winterfest Horse Show, the Horse Show Management, nor The Ranch will be in any way responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold such bodies harmless for any loss or accident to horse(s), property or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Neither the Winterfest Horse Show, the Horse Show Management, nor The Ranch will be responsible or liable for any injury or death in any way by exhibitors, spectators or employees. **WARNING: Under Colorado law, an equine professional is not liable for any injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to §13.21.119, Colorado Revised Statutes.**

Refunds and Vet-outs

Entries will be accepted through January 31st, 2023. Exhibitors canceling their entries after the official date for the closing of entries, without a veterinarian's certificate, shall forfeit all fees. Vet-outs made prior to February 10, 2023 (the start of the show), with a veterinarian's certificate, shall forfeit only the office fee and stall fees. Vet-outs made during the show (February 10, 2023 or later) with a veterinarian's certificate shall forfeit all fees with the exception of entry fees. No refunds will be made during the show. The competition will refund entry fees in the event of cancellation of classes due to severe weather or another emergency.

Health Requirements

All out-of-state horses are to be examined by a licensed veterinarian and found to be free of any infectious or communicable disease, and such information must be properly recorded on a health certificate accompanying each horse. It is recommended that horses be given influenza boosters before arriving at the horse show. For entry into the state of Colorado, a Coggins test is required.

Awards

In the event of cancellation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds of entry fees must be made upon written request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation.

No payback will be offered in any class. Championship and Stake classes: trophy and ribbons to six ribbons. Regular classes: trophy and six ribbons. Academy classes: trophy and six ribbons. *NOTE: Saturday classes: six ribbons and overall high point horse and high point rider awards, does not include academy classes.*

Scheduling

The management of the Colorado Fall Charity Winterfest Horse Show reserves the right to add, split, combine or cancel any classes. Classes with less than five entries may be withdrawn from the program at the discretion of the Horse Show Management. Juvenile, Academy and Equitation classes with four or fewer entries may be combined.

Feed and Bedding

No bedding is provided. Shavings may be ordered on your entry blank for \$9.25 per bale. Contact the show office if additional shavings are needed during the show. Hay and grain may be obtained at Bomgaars at 3720 Draft Horse Dr., Loveland, CO 80538.

Ring Procedure

The show ring will be under the absolute control of the Horse Show Manager. All entries must be ready and waiting to enter the ring promptly. The in-gate must be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring. When the gates are closed and the judge has started to work, no exhibitor who is late will be admitted. During the time of the judging, no person will be allowed in the ring except horse show officials, judges, stewards, and when necessary, trainers or attendants of the horses to be judged.

It is a tradition of the competition ring that exhibitors be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and horses properly presented. The Horse Show Management may at its discretion bar an entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Stalls

Stalls will be assigned by the Barn Manager with preference given to properly completed entries submitted by the January 31, 2023 closing date. Out-of-town and out-of-state exhibitors will be given preference if they have entries in by the closing date. Horses must be placed in assigned stalls and no change will be permitted without the consent of the Horse Show Management. Stalls are constructed of wood, metal and/or vinyl with either half-open, pipe or solid fronts and doors. Exhibitors should order only the actual number of stalls required, and only one stall per entered horse on which fees are paid will be allocated.

Exhibitors will be charged for any additional stalls used without the permission of the Horse Show Management. Because The Ranch charges the Colorado Fall Charity Winterfest Horse Show for each stall used, this will be continuously monitored throughout the show. Stall usage includes but is not limited to using stalls for hay, straw and bedding storage, storing clothing, tack and show supplies, and storage of garbage or manure. To avoid any additional charges, do not use any stalls not already assigned to you.

Stalls will not be available until 9:00am on Thursday February 9, 2023. Out-of-state horses may be granted early entry – please contact the Barn Manager for arrangements. There is a \$20 per day, per-stall fee added for early entry. Exhibitors will be billed for damage to stalls in excess of normal wear and tear. Stall charts will be posted. Any changes of entries after the closing date will be subject to management's approval and subject to a first-come/first-served basis.

Parking and Trailers

Due to fire regulations, vehicles including trailers and campers must be parked in designated parking areas. Anyone wishing hookups for campers and/or trailers must arrange for this hookup in the Horse Show office and will be charged a hookup fee. Vehicles not parked in designated parking areas WILL be towed at the owners' expense.

Arena and Warm-up Arena

The main arena and warm-up arenas are indoors. Both arenas have footing composed of 60% sand and 40% non-fat soluble clay.

TBA (To Be Announced) Division

TBA classes are classes that might not normally fill, but which may be desired by an exhibitor. You may pick a TBA slot for any Open, English, Morgan, A/HA/AA or Saddlebred class so long as it is a defined class as listed in the current Federation Rule Book. If you are interested in adding a class in a TBA slot, contact the Horse Show Secretary, pick the slot you wish to use for that class, add a \$35.00 TBA Sponsorship Fee to your entry blank and then enter your horse in that class for a regular class entry fee. Post entry fees will NOT apply! When the show office opens, the class chosen for the slot will be posted, and any other qualifying exhibitors will be able to enter that class with no post entry fee!

Academy Division

No Federation membership or Show Pass fee required for riders in this division. Riders in this division must be riding a horse who earns his living as a school horse. Riders may not enter any other division at this show. Shirts: long-sleeved, button-down shirts with a tie are required. Vests or sweaters (in cooler weather) worn over the shirt and tie are optional. Pants: to consist of jodhpurs, breeches or black pants in good condition. Blue jeans are acceptable ONLY in Western classes. Footwear: to consist of paddock, jodhpur, hunt or cowboy boots. HELMETS ARE REQUIRED IN ALL ACADEMY CLASSES FOR RIDERS 18 AND UNDER AND ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR ADULT RIDERS AS WELL.

The rider will be judged on basic equitation skills and his/her ability to control the horse. Once a rider has shown in a Walk/Trot/Canter class at any recognized or non-recognized show, he/she is no longer eligible to show in the Walk/Trot Division. No extended gaits or backing will be asked for in either Academy division.
