#### **Rules and Regulations**

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. It is expected that exhibitors, owners, lessees, trainers and coaches will be familiar with the Federation breed and class specifications regarding your particular breed / discipline. A current Federation Rule Book will be available in the Horse Show Office.

Changes made to the prize list and/or schedule will be posted at the following URL: <u>http://www.ShowMeTheRibbons.org/Classic.html</u> or on the Colorado Classic Facebook page. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to check the URL noted above or check in at the Horse Show Office for any changes that may affect your entry.

#### Entries

Entries may be made on line (and are preferred) at **horses howsonline.com** or can be made in writing and signed by the (1) exhibitor, (2) the rider, driver, handler, vaulter or longeur, (3) the trainer, and (4) the coach, if applicable, or by the agent(s) of such person(s) and must be accompanied by funds to cover all applicable fees. In the case of a rider, driver, handler, vaulter or longeur under the age of 18, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer, must sign an entry blank on the minor's be half. Make checks payable to Colorado Classic Horse Show. See payment info in the horse show office.

#### **Post Entries**

Post entries are <u>any</u> entries made after the advertised closing date of April 5, 2024. The Horse Show Committees requests that entries be made in advance prior to the closing date. Any entry received after the closing date of April 5, 2024 will be considered a post entry and will be accepted, <u>at the discretion of the Horse Show Management</u>, with an additional charge of \$40 per horse, payment in full (or a signed, blank check made payable to Colorado Classic Horse Show) and a fully completed and signed Entry Blank. Post entries can only be accepted prior to the starting of the class and upon signature of exhibitor or his/her agent and trainer.

#### **Personal Checks**

Any check refused by the bank for any reason will be assessed a \$60.00 penalty. Then the full obligation, plus the \$60.00 penalty, must be covered by a money order, cashier's check or cash. All checks must be pre-printed with the current information (name, address and telephone number).

#### The Horse Show Management reserves the right to refuse payment in the form of a check from any exhibitor.

#### Office and Exercise Schedules

Schedules for office hours and exercising times will be posted at the Show Secretary's office.

#### **Courtesy and Disputes**

The Colorado Classic Horse Show reserves the right to eliminate from competition and remove from show grounds, without liability or recourse of any kind, any exhibitor(s) or person(s) who exhibit offensive behavior, engage in any illegal activity, display disrespect to officials, exhibitors, vol unteers, spectators, or any other participants. Such conduct will disqualify horse(s) from adjudication and the owner shall forfeit entrance and all fees. Exhibitors shall not approach the judge regarding a decision without first requesting permission from Show Management. No disputes shall be heard by the Show Committee until the horse show is over. Decisions made by the Show Management shall be considered final.

#### Condition of Entry

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Colorado Classic Horse Show Management. Neither the Colorado Classic Horse Show, the Horse Show Management, or The National Western will be in any case responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold such bodies harmless for any loss or accident to horse(s), property or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Neither the Colorado Classic Horse Show, the Horse Show Management, nor the National Western will be responsible or liable for any injury or death in any way by exhibitors, spectators or employees. **WARNING:** Under Colorado law, an equine professional is not liable for any injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to §13.21.119, Colorado Revised Statutes.

#### Refunds and Vet-outs

Entries will be accepted through April 5,2024. Exhibitors canceling their entries <u>after</u> the official date for the closing of entries, <u>without</u> a veterinarian's certificate, shall forfeit <u>all</u> fees. Vet-outs made <u>prior</u> to April 19,2024 (the start of the show), <u>with</u> a veterinarian's certificate, shall forfeit only the office fee and stall fees. Vet-outs made <u>during</u> the show (April 19,2024 or later) <u>with</u> a veterinarian's certificate shall forfeit all fees with the exception of entry fees. <u>No refunds</u> will be made during the show. The competition will refund entry fees in the event of cancelation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency.

#### Health Requirements

All out-of-state horses are to be examined by a licensed veterinarian and found to be free of any infectious or communicable disease, and such information must be properly recorded on a health certificate accompanying each horse. It is recommended that horses be given influenza boosters before arriving at the horse show. For entry into the state of Colorado, a Coggins test is required. Temperature logs (5-7 days prior to arrival) may be required of all horses attending based on recommendations by the Colorado State Veterinary Office and the National Western Management.

#### Awards

Fees

In the event of cancelation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds of entry fees must be made upon written request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancelation.

No payback will be offered in any class. Championship and Stake classes: trophy and ribbons to six ribbons. Regular classes: ribbons awarded through sixth place.

#### Scheduling

The management of the Colorado Classic Horse Show reserves the right to add, split, combine or cancel any classes. Classes with less than five entries may be withdrawn from the program at the discretion of the Horse Show Management. Juvenile, Academy and Equitation classes with four or fewer entries may be combined. Medal classes that do not have the required number of entries to be complete may be canceled.

#### Numbers

Each horse shall have the SAME NUMBER throughout the show. This number is to appear on the back of the rider, driver, or handler, or any conspicuous place. Any entry without a number in the ring shall not be judged.

#### Feed and Bedding

No bedding is provided. Bedding and hay may be obtained from the Feed Proprietor selling these items at the show. Contact the Feed Proprietor (In Him Feed/Sue Sayler 303.358.1116) for all your bedding and hay needs. Shavings: \$10.50 per bale and can be ordered on your entry blank. Grass Hay available for \$18.00 per bale. You are responsible for your payment and at no time will the Colorado Classic Horse Show Management be responsible for payment.

#### **Ring Procedure**

The show ring will be under the absolute control of the Horse Show Manager. All entries must be ready and waiting to enter the ring promptly. The in-gate must be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring. When the gates are closed and the judge has started to work, no exhibitor who is late will be admitted. During the time of the judging, no person will be allowed in the ring except horse show officials, judges, stewards, and when necessary, trainers or attendants of the horses to be judged.

# It is a tradition of the competition ring that exhibitors be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and horses properly presented. The Horse Show Management may at its discretion bar an entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

#### **Definition Of Terms**

<u>Junior Horse</u>: A junior horse is a horse 4 years old and under. Birthday is to be considered as of January 1, after the year in which he/she was born.

Limit Horse Classes: Open to horses who have not won six (6) first place ribbons in an under-saddle class or driving class at a horse show.

Novice Classes: are open to horses not having won three (3) first place ribbons in an under-saddle class or a driving class at a horse show. A limit or novice entry is as of the closing date of entries. Ribbons won in an under-saddle class shall not count towards limit or novice status if the horse is transferred to driving and vice versa, i.e., Five Gaited to Pleasure Driving or Fine Harness to English Pleasure, etc.

Amateur: As defined under USEF Rules, Chapter 8, and Subchapter 8c. Amateurs and Professionals. Article GR1306 Amateur Status and Article GR1307 Amateur Certification.



#### Parking and Trailers

Due to fire regulations, cars, trailers, vans and campers must be parked in designated parking areas. Anyone wishing hookups for campers and/or trailers must arrange for this hookup in the horse show office and will be charged a hookup fee. TRAILERS PARKED BEHIND THE PADDOCK AREA WILL BE TOWED. All Trailers must be parked in the North Lot (Lot H). All vehicles not parked in designed parking areas WILL be towed at the owner's expense.

#### Camper Hook-Up

Spaces with electric only will be assigned on a first come, first-served basis (no advance reservations), by barn manager Sue Sayler 303.358.1116 or show secretary Jacki Rosellen 303.931.8740. Showers are available in the horse barn restrooms. Horse show management will assign hook-up spaces and collect payment. A fee of \$35 per camper per night must be paid in advance to the horse show management.

#### Farrier

No farriers other than the official show farrier or an appointed assistant will be allowed to work on the show grounds once the show begins at 10 a.m. Friday, April 19th. Jon Stroh will be available Friday, April 19 through Sunday, April 21.

#### Stalls

Stalls will be assigned by the Barn Manager with preference given to properly completed entries submitted by the April 5, 2024 closing date. Out-of-town and out-of-state exhibitors will be given preference if they have entries in by the closing date. Horses must be placed in assigned stalls and no change will be permitted without the consent of the Horse Show Management. Stalls are constructed of wood, metal and/or vinyl with either half-open, pipe or solid fronts and doors. Exhibitors should order only the actual number of stalls required, and only one stall per entered horse on which fees are paid will be allocated.

Removal of stall panels by exhibitors is prohibited. Exhibitors desiring removal of stall panels must contact the Barn Manager, who will coordinate the removal with N ational Western. Only National Western can remove these panels. Colorado Classic Horse Show will charge \$35 per panel for such removal and the exhibitor is responsible for payment.

Exhibitors will be charged for any additional stalls used without the permission of the Horse Show Management. Because the N ational Western charges the Colorado Classic Horse Show for each stall used, this will be continuously monitored throughout the show. Stall usage includes but is not limited to using stalls for hay, straw and bedding storage, storing clothing tack and show supplies, and storage of garbage or manure. To avoid any additional charges, do not use any stalls not already assigned to you.

Stalls will not be available until 12:00pm on Wednesday April 17, 2024. Out-of-state horses may be granted early entry – please contact the Show & Barn Manager for arrangements. There is a 30 per-day, per-stall fee added for early entry. Exhibitors will be billed for damage to stalls in excess of normal wear and tear. Stall charts will be posted. Any changes of entries after the closing date will be subject to management's approval and subject to a first-come/first-served basis. There is a 30 Stall Fee for horses attending the Ranch Riding classes (79, 80, & 81) only – occupation of such stalls is limited to 3 hours on Saturday, April 20th. No first bedding is supplied. Exhibitors, horses and belongings must be off the premises by 11:00pm on Sunday, April 21, 2024. Out-of-state horses may be granted late departure – please contact the Show & Barn Manager for arrangements.

#### Arena and Warm-up Arena

The main arena measures 150' x 300'. The warm-up/paddock measures 90' x 190'. Both arenas have footing composed of 60% sand and 40% non-fat soluble clay.

### **Academy Division**

Riders in this division must be riding a horse who earns his living as a school horse. Riders may not enter any other division at this show. Shirts: long sleeved, button down shirts with a tie are required. Vests or sweaters (in cooler weather) worn over the shirt and tie are optional. Pants: to consist of jodhpurs, breeches or black pants in good condition. Blue jeans are acceptable ONLY in Western classes. Footwear: to consist of paddock, jodhpur, hunt or cowboy boots. HELMETS ARE REQUIRED IN ALL ACADEMY CLASSES FOR RIDERS 18 AND UNDER AND ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR ADULT RIDERS AS WELL.

The rider will be judged on basic equitation skills and his/her ability to control the horse. Once a rider has shown in a Walk/Trot/Canter class at any recognized or non-recognized show, he/she is no longer eligible to show in the Walk/Trot Division. No extended gaits or backing will be asked for in either Academy division.

In 2019, a group of concerned American Saddlebred enthusiasts began discussions about taking a proactive approach to combat issues that were plaguing the American Saddlebred industry. These issues include decline in ASB registrations and transfers; difficulty in bridging the gap between

academy participation and horse ownership; young professionals leaving the industry for more secure employment opportunities; professionals and owners, alike, feeling left behind by the Industry's focus on elite levels of competition...the list goes on.

From discussions, a vision was formed to network mainstream horse shows across the country and offer a "Crown Jewel" competition for this core market. This concept resulted in the new Monarch Show Series National Championship that will be held in the Coliseum of Champions on the Illinois State Fairgrounds Sept. 6-10, 2023.

## WHAT MAKES THE MONARCH NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP UNIQUE?

Unique to the Monarch National Championship Horse Show is the requirement of qualification of horse/rider combinations to show in their respective divisions that offer Monarch National Championships by competing at four horse shows in the Monarch Network. Horse shows qualify for the Monarch Network by having less than 400 horses, capable of verifying results, and willing to offer as many classes from the Monarch suggested class list as possible. The Monarch National Championship also offers a full slate of open breed classes that horses do not need to qualify for.

Network mainstream horse shows across the country and offer a Crown Jewel competition for this core market, injecting a new level of excitement and inclusiveness for competitors that enjoy competing regionally

Also unique to the MNC is the "Single Bit" Division. Single Bit classes are open to Amateur or Juvenile riders in a snaffle bit with a running or German martingale, draw reins are also permissible. Any leverage bit rein is prohibited through the martingale. A Pelham or 'Tom Thumb' bit without martingale, shank not to exceed 5 inches, is also allowed. All tack should be of show ring quality. Riders are to wear appropriate show ring attire. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into another division, with the exception of the Model, Showmanship, Pattern and In-Hand Obstacle Classes. This division can be utilized by new horse rider combinations that want to "get their feet wet" without having to show in a full bridle, riders wanting to "level up" from academy, or horses that simply do not prefer to wear the full bridle. Due to popular request, additional Elite "Single Bit" classes have been added, and are open to both Professionals and Amateurs.

Additional classes will be added to the show schedule as requested by potential exhibitors. Not only will the Coliseum of Champions be utilized for the MNC, but also the neighboring "covered arena" will be used for a slate of additional classes such as Open Western Trail, In-Hand Obstacle Course, Reinsmanship, Pairs Class and more!
